

National Neutropenia Network **SENIOR AMBASSADOR VOLUNTEER** Position Description

Program Vision

The National Neutropenia Network (NNN) Senior Ambassador program directly supports the mission of the NNN by building awareness of Neutropenia through advocacy and education.

Purpose

National Neutropenia Network Senior Ambassadors act as a liaison between the NNN and the community at large by serving as advocates to help raise awareness of Neutropenia, provide general education of the disease process, and raise funds to support Neutropenia research and peer support.

Roles & Responsibilities

Specific responsibilities can include, but are not limited to:

- * Outreach with other Neutropenia families/individuals to facilitate support and education
- * Community awareness events such as publishing individual Neutropenia journey story via local media outlets (newspaper publications, local TV news, etc), schools, churches, social gatherings, etc
- * Manage and implement a fundraising event/platform of choice to benefit Neutropenia research, care and/or peer support
- * Work with the NNN to plan/coordinate/facilitate virtual seminars pertaining to Neutropenia care/support/research
- * Become a peer support volunteer with the NNN
- * Be actively involved with conference planning and event execution
- * Individual Senior Ambassador volunteer work will be highlighted in NNN online, printed and social media platforms at the discretion of the NNN executive Board

Desired Qualifications (application based)

- * Self-motivated and proactive: ability to create and manage independent projects
- * Community minded: strong desire to support the mission of the NNN
- * Strong interpersonal skills: the ability to build relationships and relate to others and the NNN executive staff
- * Exhibit solid, reasonable goals to contribute to outreach and fundraising to benefit the Neutropenia community

Eligibility

- * College age or older
- * Personal connection with diagnosis and awareness of Neutropenia
- * Former Junior Ambassadors may apply
- * NNN Board Members are not eligible to apply
- * Commitment to volunteer will be for the calendar year January 1-December 31
- * Volunteer positions will be renewable with re-application process year to year
- * Application deadline will be November 20th
- * Individuals chosen to represent the NNN Senior Ambassador Volunteer program will be at the discretion of the NNN executive team as well as the need to terminate individual positions

Compensation

The National Neutropenia Network Senior Ambassador Volunteer position is purely volunteer and individuals will receive no monetary or other compensation for their role.
