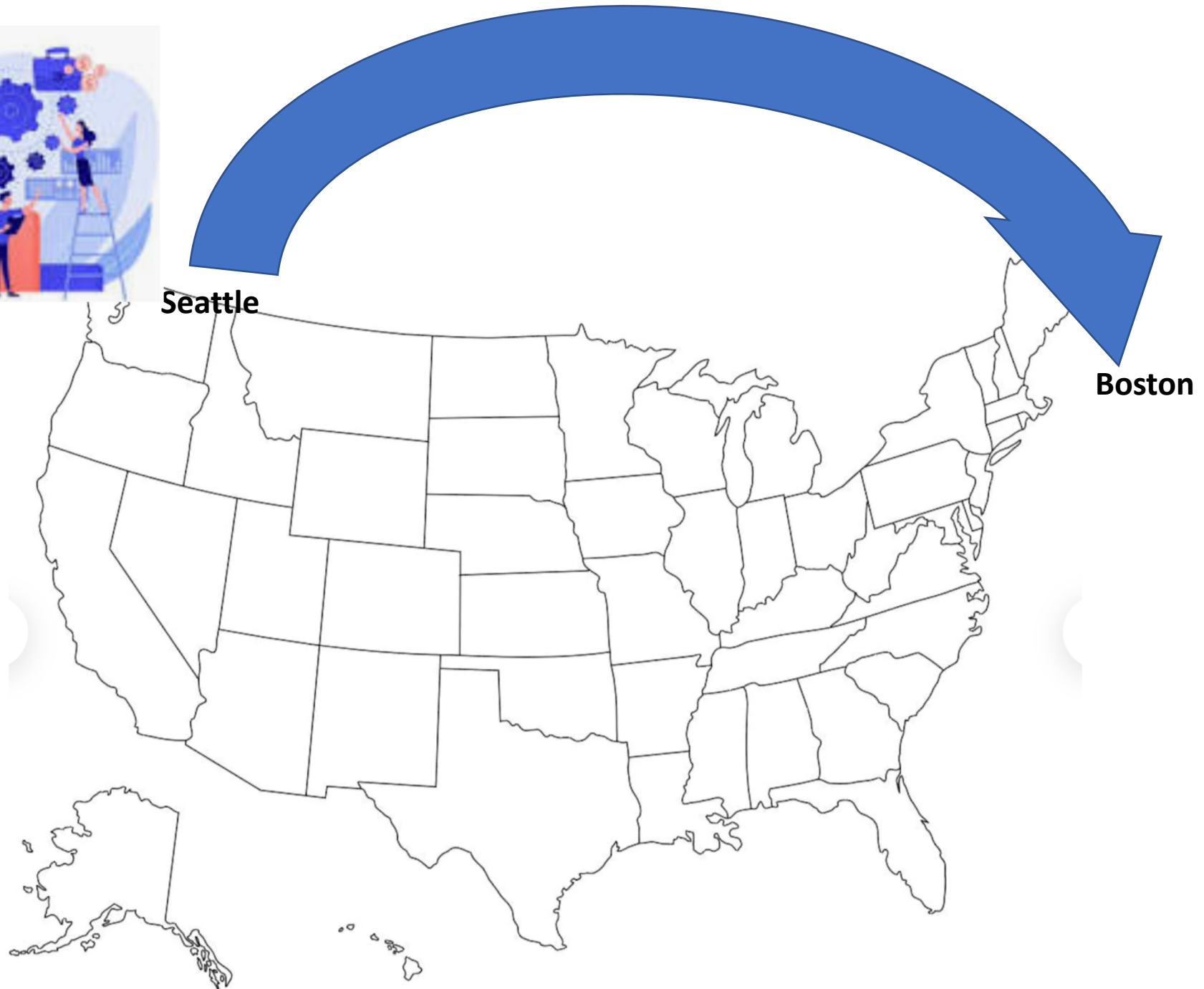

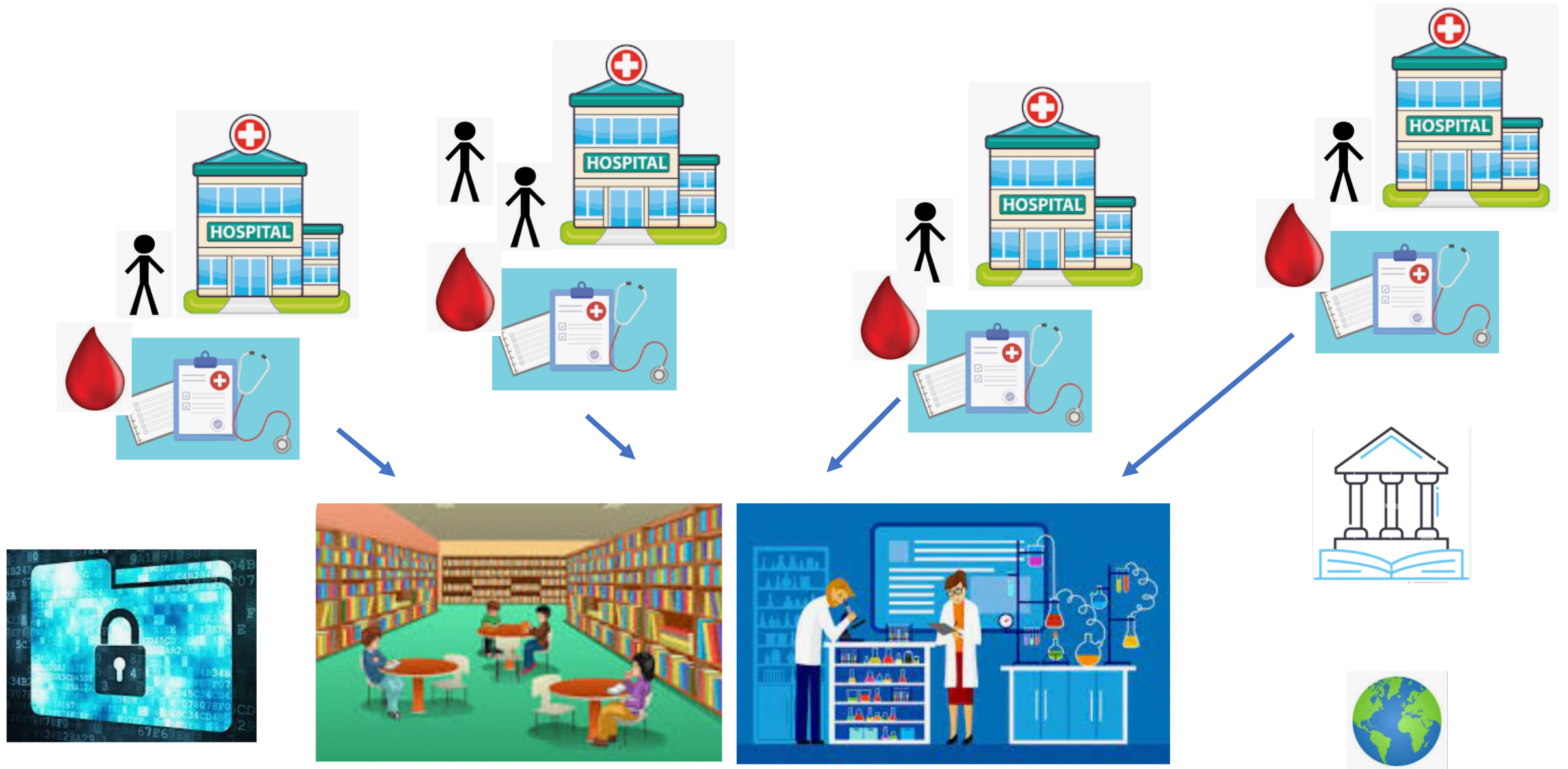

Registries are a partnership between patients and researchers.



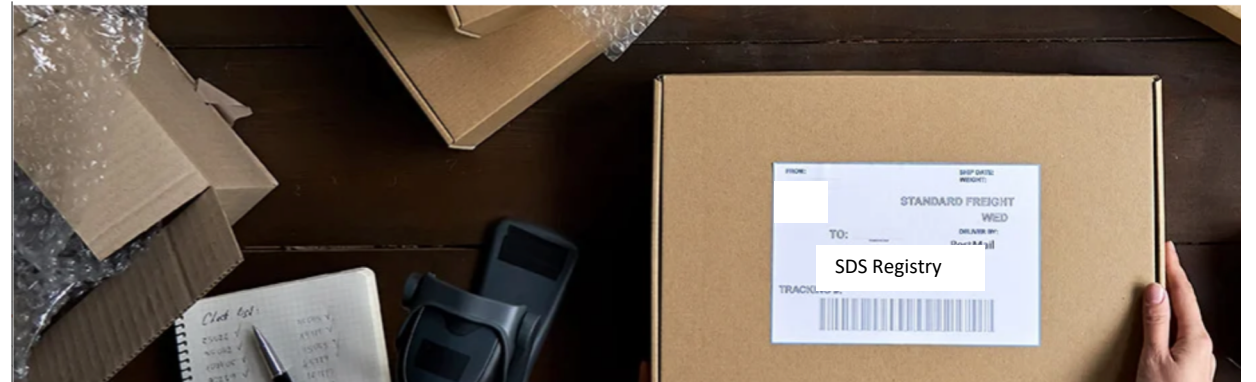
SCNIR: updates

- All previously collected records will be transferred to the Boston office and will continue to be studied.
- All previous SCNIR participants must re-consent (using the new Boston consent form) in order to continue to share medical records and samples
- Consent may now be provided electronically

SCNIR samples



- Obtained when blood or marrow are being drawn anyway as part of clinical care (no extra needle pokes!). Longitudinal samples are especially useful.
- Call/email SCNIR prior to the lab draw/marrow exam: we will send you a pre-paid/pre-addressed box with sample tubes. Just put the samples in the box and mail it.
